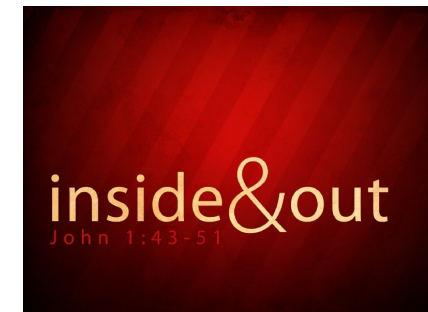

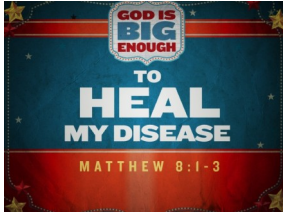

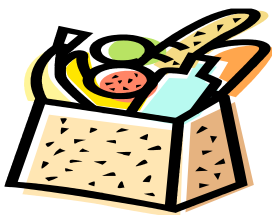

parcels.

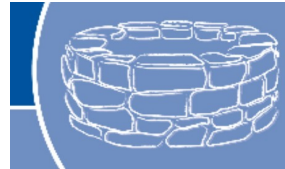
