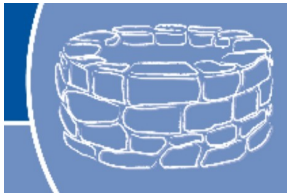

cost just 15p, even from a mobile and no matter
how long it lasts for. one number for
emergencies and one for non-emergency
