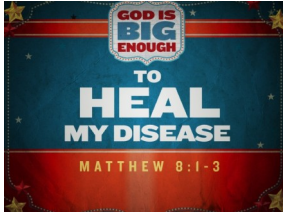

Newsletter In an attempt to reduce costs we are experimenting by printing the newsletter in black and white.

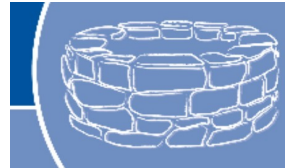
Precis of PCC Minutes The précis are on the welcome desk, please take and read.
